PART D TERMS OF REFERENCE / SCOPE OF WORK

1. BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTION

The Water Research Commission (WRC) is a national entity established in terms of the Water Research Act (Act No 34 of 1971), to coordinate and fund water research in South Africa.

The WRC requires to appoint a service provider to develop the new ways of working for the WRC. Since March last year when the country went into lockdown, the WRC entered a remote way of working. This way of working has had benefits and disadvantages. As detailed in CP21, the WRC will in this financial year, determine the new ways of working for the WRC that will capitalize on the benefits of the remote working and provide solutions for the disadvantages experienced

2. SCOPE OF WORK: REQUIREMENT/SPECIFICATION

The WRC requires a services provider with the required experience to co-create a more intentional model that will be the new way of working for the WRC as follows.

Phase 1 - Conduct a remote/hybrid readiness assessment

Phase 2 - Gap Analysis - After the readiness assessment is completed develop a detailed gap analysis report the gap analysis must unpack extensive detail of:

- current environment.
- the appetite and support for change,
- potential barriers to success.

The report must be structured under following categories:

- Technology Infrastructure
- Organisational Culture (Do we have a digitised Organisational culture)
- Leadership Profile (Does our leadership style support decentralisation)
- Performance Drivers (What are the WRC's unique performance drivers. How is performance measured and rewarded)
- Organisational Profile (Critical business drivers, skill, activity and job mix)

Phase 3 - Develop the intentional model for the WRC

- Design a customised way of working model, based on the results of the hybrid/remote readiness gap analysis, that is tailored to the WRC's unique environment.
- This model will provide the necessary tools to ensure that new working model can become a



sustainable and successful driver of a future-fit WRC. It must ensure productivity, maintain, and enhance the WRC's culture, support the WRC's key business success drivers.

Workshop model to employees, get feedback, before it will be finalised.

3. EVALUATION PHASES

The received proposals will be evaluated in different phases in order to arrive to the final phase of bid award, and the phases will be as follows:

- 3.1 Phase One Screening of the minimum requirements documents
- 3.2 Phase Two Technical Evaluation
- 3.2 Phase Three Price and Preference (B-BBEE)

3.1 Phase One (01): Screening of the minimum requirements documents

- Submission of the original or certified B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate or original B-BBEE Sworn Affidavit in case of EME and QSE)
- Submission of fully completed SBD8 (Declaration of Bidders Past SCM Practice),
- Submission of fully completed SBD9 (Certificate of Independent Bid Determination),
- Submission of Central Supplier Database (CSD) Compliance History Report.
- NB: Submit <u>company profile</u> which detailed knowledge the service provider have in the human resource discipline and specialize in employee wellness.

NB: Any bidders who did not sign and submit any of the requested documents may be disqualified.
