## PART D TERMS OF REFERENCE / SCOPE OF WORK

#### 1. BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTION

The WRC operates as legislated by the Water Research Act (Act 34 of 1971) and is an entity of national importance to ensure water security, support to the DWS and water sector stakeholders through funding of research entities (universities, consultants and SMMEs). The Primary Function of the WRC is to (1) Promote coordination, cooperation, and communication in water research; (2) Establish water research needs and priorities; (3) Stimulate and fund water research according to priority; (4) Promote the effective transfer of information and technology; and (5) Enhance knowledge and capacity building within the water sector.

As a specialised and technical entity responsive to the National, Regional and Global requirements on water security research and development solutions, innovation as well as knowledge and information dissemination. The new global requirements including accountability and governance legislations and the impacts of climate change have gradually resulted in an ever evolving and growing organization that has to date remained relevant. Thus, The WRC should also become agile to positively respond the to the various requests from the sector partners and like-minded institutions on RDI related work, while not compromising on the primary mandate. The WRC must consistently evaluate itself to ensure that the growth of the organization to serve legislative and other requirements and has a sustainable organizational operating model that is fit for purpose and can remain sustainable into the future

To ensure maintenance of the relevance or enhancement thereof, the WRC seeks to develop a five-year Outcomes-based strategy as directed by the DPME framework of 2019.20 for a period of 2022.23-2027.28 financial year, with clear annual targets to be achieved (as translated into 5 APPs).

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK: REQUIREMENT / SPECIFICATION

The WRC requires to appoint a professional service provider to conduct a five (5) year strategy and APP development as follows:

- Conduct a strategic planning session with Executive management
- Conduct a consultative process with WRC MANCO on the strategy development
- Prepare the WRC five-year strategy document in line with the DPME framework
- Prepare the WRC 2023.24 APP, with SMART indicators, technical descriptors to ensure compliance with the DPME and other statutory requirements

- Stakeholder engagement report
- A five-year strategic plan for the WRC
