Rationale

The challenge is many rural and peri-urban areas is that property is not cadastral (no erf no on municipal billing system)... it seems it's impossible to bill that household. In our more rural provinces affluent people are intentionally building in land that is not cadastral (issued by chiefs or just illegally occupied as the owner cannot be located). The key questions is how should these properties be incorporated into rural municipal billing and revenue systems. So some guideline (that is legally appropriate) providing a quick-fix and outlining (in detail) the process of cadastralising for billing would be really helpful in tackling revenue and NRW in these areas.
