## Cream of SA's aquatic scientists gather in Free State

he Southern African Society of Aquatic Scientists held its annual conference at Thaba Nchu from 22 to 26 June. Around 100 delegates attended this year's conference, which provided a forum for discussion on aquatic science topics ranging from ecology and management to fisheries, parasitology, pollution and alien invasive species. True to its nature of being a student-friendly society, the conference offered an opportunity for many students to present their research work – many for the first time.
