Through funding, human resource development and the provision of the necessary research facilities in order





Research and Innovation Support and Advancement

- Institutional capacity (IEPD/HICD)- World class Universities and Equipment
- Human Capacity (HICD/KFD) Highly skilled people in sufficient numbers capable of creating new knowledge and to translate existing knowledge in an innovative way
- Knowledge Production & Development (KFD/ARIC) New knowledge/existing knowledge (Research output) that is internationally competitive
- Application and Innovation (ARIC) Knowledge Application, Development and Innovation – technological and social
- Benchmarking (Evaluation & rating of individuals) Recognized and respected by peers on the basis of quality and impact of research
